The Morning Mile is returning to Kelly Mill. This is an amazing walk/running program where students will come out to the track 7:10 - 7:40AM on their designated morning starting Monday March 14th!

Students will first go to their classroom to check in with their homeroom teachers and leave any items, backpacks, water bottles. Students may then come to the track or the gym, depending on the weather, and run laps. At 7:30AM students who need breakfast will be dismissed. By 7:35AM we will begin cleaning up and recording laps with the goal of having all students on their way back to the classroom by 7:40AM.

For every five miles that a student completes they will receive a foot charm and necklace. (This program had been continuing as part of PE classes until now). All charms will be handed out when students come to PE.
